## What's Happening in Second Grade

March is Women's History Month

Reading - This week, Mrs. Burroughs's reading group students will share the puppets they created from the novel, The Littles. My group will also read a passage about Amelia Earhart and answer comprehension questions. All students will begin reading Penguin Chick from our reading anthologies with the target skill being 'Main Ideas and Details' and spiraling the skill, 'Cause and Effect'.

Religion - We will continue preparing students for 1st Communion.

Language Arts - We will work with phonics skills using the -er, -ir, -ur phonograms. Students begin work on a super-fun, Superhero Writing activity. This week, our class will also begin reciting our memorized poems to the class!
