What's Happening in Second Grade

Happy Catholic Schools Week

Reading - This week we will continue our story, 'Schools Around the World.'

Language Arts - Our focus this week is on quotation marks and character dialogue.

Math - We will continue learning about three-digit subtraction.

Religion - Students will learn about the HRS parish outreach group called 'The Homebound Eucharistic Ministry.'
