What's Happening in Second Grade

Reading - We will continue reading the realistic fiction story titled, 'Luke Goes to Bat' and a biography about Jackie Robinson. ⚾ Our target skill is sequence of events. Students in Mrs. Burroughs's reading group will begin the Beverly Cleary novel, Socks, on Thursday.

Language Arts - Phonics: identify words with the complex vowel sound /oo/ as in 'good' and 'should'.

Poem of the Week: 'My Robot's Misbehaving'

Spelling Words: knight, kind, spy, child, light, wild, right, fry, why, high
Challenge Words: brightly, frighten **There is a Spelling Test on Friday.**

Math - We begin our new chapter which teaches telling time on an analog clock. Students will work through our lesson on telling time to the 1/4 hour.
