What's Happening in Second Grade

Reading - This week our students will partner read - 'Biblioburro' as well as the paired selection, Landing on Your Feet, a narrative non-fiction piece, where students will look for details that support the narrator's traits. Later this week, we will begin our new text set with the shared read, Starry Night, where we look at characters' perspectives.

Language Arts - Grammar activities include present-tense action verbs as well as learning about open syllables.
