What's Happening in Second Grade

Reading - We will begin lesson one in our WONDERS Anthology. Our anchor text is Big, Red Lollipop and it's genre is realistic fiction. For our learning goal, we will apply strategies and skills to read realistic fiction. We will blend phonemes (putting sounds together to make a word), segment words into phonemes (separating a word into the sounds we hear) and substitute phonemes (changing the first sound in a word to make a new word). We will identify, build, decode, and spell words with short vowels a, i, o

Spelling Words: has, wag, bad, six, will, sat, had, fix, him, if (10 words)

Challenge words: chips, flash

Our first spelling test will be next Friday, 9/18

Math - Time will be spent reviewing addition and subtraction facts as we begin Topic One. We will learn about the commutative property ($5+8$ and $8+5$) and using a number line to help us add. Essential question: What are strategies for finding addition and subtraction facts?

Religion - Students will learn that the simple act of making the Sign of the Cross is a very short, meaningful prayer.

Social-Emotional Learning: In this week's lesson, your child will learn that their best skills have developed as a result of practicing, trying hard, and asking for help.
